## JUDGE OF THE 37<sup>th</sup> NATIONAL SHOW OF HEREFORD CATTLE Mr Richard Bartle

I have been involved in pedigree cattle breeding for forty years and judging for much of that time. At present I am the herd manager for the Dinmore herds of



British Limousin, British Blue and Aberdeen Angus. We also bred Beef Shorthorns but dispersed last year breaking two breed records with a top price of 24,000gns.

I have been very fortunate to judge many prestigious shows including national shows for the Irish Limousin, Blonde, Longhorn and Devon and, last year, the Bicentenary celebration for the Beef Shorthorns. I have also judged in Paris, Royal Smithfield and English and Welsh Winter Fairs.

In the show ring, I have had much success including the Burke Trophy twice and the Fitzhugh twice, and many interbreed championships.

I will be looking for a well-balanced, easy fleshing Hereford with breed character and, most importantly, style and locomotion. I also judged a regional Hereford herd competition two years ago and was very impressed by the easy fleshing abilities and ease of management of the Hereford with their great grazing ability and hardiness.

#### YOUNG HANDLERS COMPETITION

#### Judge: Miss Maddie Clarke

#### FREE to Enter!

To take place in our Judging Ring immediately after the class judging and Championships. Entrants will enter in age order, oldest first, with different arm bands to indicate which section they are contesting:

i)	under 14 years	Rosettes to section winners - cash prizes to <b>all</b> entrants.
ii)	14 - 18 years	The 'Dendor Memorial' show stick to the Champion Young
iii)	19 - 26 years	Handler.

The judge will take into account the way in which the animal is shown and presented. It is imperative that competitors are correctly dressed and are wearing suitably protective footwear. Correct dress for the Young Handlers Competitions is either white coats or UKHY uniform. The quality of the animal(s) being handled by the young handlers will not be considered for this competition.

Entries will be accepted on the run up to the show and on show day to Laura Vincent. It will be helpful, for our planning purposes, if an indication of intention to enter Young Handlers could be given when entering cattle.

### HERD ADVERTISEMENTS IN THE SHOW CATALOGUE

Breeders may advertise their herds in the official Tenbury Show Catalogue at £50 for a full page or £30 for ½ page of **print-ready copy**. If additional artwork is required this will be charged at cost. Members sponsoring the Show (£120 or more) are entitled to a **free** ½ page advert.

If a calf is shown at foot please state its sex, date of birth and 3 sire on the entry form. 

#### **Rules and Regulations**

- 1. The Rules of the Tenbury Agricultural Society apply (copy available from the Tenbury Show Secretary). No dogs allowed on showground.
- 2. The Show will be conducted under DEFRA regulations in place at the time.
- 3. All animals entered for this Show (including calves at foot) must be entered, or eligible for entry, in the Herd Book of Hereford Cattle, Horned Section.
- 4. All exhibitors must be members of the Hereford Cattle Society and the National Hereford Club.
- 5. Cattle exhibited must be the property of the exhibitor at the entry closing date.
- Entries, on the official Entry Form, must be accompanied by the correct fee and must reach the Entries Secretary, Sarah Cowle, by 5<sup>th</sup> July. All information requested on the Entry Form must be provided. Late or substitute entries will *NOT* normally be accepted. Cancellation of the Show for any reason will result in full refund of entry fees.
- It may be necessary to amalgamate some Classes if there are insufficient entries. Conversely, if there are more than 18 entries per Class such Classes may be divided.
- 8. All Show animals must be on the showground by 7.30am and be securely tied in the section allocated to them in the cattle lines.
- White coats must be worn by all exhibitors & attendants in the ring during classes 1-14 and championships. UKHY uniforms or white coats may be worn in the YH classes.
- 10. All prize-winning cattle must join the Parade of Hereford Cattle in the afternoon or forfeit their prize money.
- 11. No cattle may be removed from the showground before 4.30pm.
- 12. An objection or protest should be submitted to the Secretary of Tenbury Show within 30 minutes of the Judge's decision, together with a deposit of £50. Such deposit shall be forfeited if the decision is sustained.
- 13. Overnight accommodation for cattle: Covered standings, no sides, straw and water will be provided
