Tenbury Show Equine Flu Protocol

With the current outbreaks of equine flu. Please be reminded of our equine flu protocol. Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination then 2nd vaccination between 21-92 days later), Followed by the first booster (150-215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose. Foals; In foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born. Foals should be vaccinated at 6 months to commence their primary course

We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times.

Vaccinations are subject to local risk assessment by the attending veterinarians.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NEITHER VACCINATION CERTIFICATES NOR PASSPORTS SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO THE SHOW. HOWEVER RANDOM CHECKS WILL BE CARRIED OUT
