The Tenbury Agricultural Society Ltd, privacy policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, that you provide to us or that we may receive from others about you, will be processed by us. It includes data that we hold electronically and in paper files.

Details of entries will be published in the catalogue and passed to our printers, solely for the purpose of compiling that publication. Results information may be published (in printed form and online) and provided to the Press and Breed Societies for publication. Information relating to exhibitors and their animals may be provided to DEFRA, Trading Standards, Animal & Plant Health Agency (APHA), British Cattle Movement Service (BCMS), SAC, Breed Societies, County Councils, Veterinary Advisors and others who have regulatory access. Please refer to our website www.tenburyshow.co.uk for full details of our Privacy Policy.

Horses must have been vaccinated to comply with the requirements of the primary course (1st vaccination then 2nd vaccination between 21-92 days later), Followed by the first booster (150-215 days) and all subsequent boosters. Horses may compete having received the primary course and prior to the booster but not within 7 days of receiving a vaccine dose. Foals In foal mares that have already had vaccinations of primary course should be vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal is due to be born.

Foals should be vaccinated at 6 months to commence their primary course
We urge all owners to adhere to strict biosecurity protocols at all times. Vaccinations are subject to local risk assessment by the attending veterinarians.

PLEASE NOTE THAT NEITHER VACCINATION CERTIFICATES NOR PASSPORTS SHOULD BE SENT TO THE SHOW OFFICE PRIOR TO THE SHOW. HOWEVER RANDOM CHECKS WILL BE CARRIED OUT ON THE SHOWGROUND DURING THE SHOW

All Competitors and Exhibitors must agree to abide by the Rules set down

1. All Horses and Ponies must be named on the entry form and the details of owner and rider completed in full.
2. **The Committee reserves the right to alter rotation of events, but the order of programme will be adhered to if possible.**
3. No person will be allowed in the ring except the Judges, Officials, Stewards and Competitors.
4. **Competitors must follow instructions displayed on the Showground and in the Ring and those given by Stewards or over the loudspeakers**
5. TICKET will be issued for entry to the showground, competitors will be admitted free on the basis of one person per horse with one Stock Attendant per vehicle, all other occupants of the vehicle will be charged.
6. **NO PEDESTRIANS will be allowed on the horse walkway, only horses and handlers**
7. No refunds for entry charges will be given in the Secretary's Tent.
8. **No refunds for withdrawals after the closing date**
9. All competitors entering events with age qualifications, as date of show must produce birth certificate if required.
10. **Competitors entering the lead rein classes in any separate section may not enter any classes off the lead in that section on that pony.**
11. **Prize money will only be paid out on the day of the Show and may be collected from the Horse & Pony Secretary's tent 2 hours after class. No prize money will be paid after the show day**
12. **1st Prize Winners may participate in the Grand Parade at 2.30.pm approx and any 2nd or 3rd prize winners who would also like to parade will be most welcome.**
13. **The decision of the Committee or anyone appointed by them, in all cases of dispute and on all questions as to the conduct of the Show shall be absolutely final**
14. Exhibitors shall be responsible for the correctness of their entries which must be lodged with the Secretary on or before the dates fixed & published. Entries should be made on forms provided, all horses & ponies must be named and details of owner or rider filled in. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques should be made payable to the Tenbury Agricultural Society Limited, or T.A.S. Ltd. No telephone entries will be accepted.
15. **Any complaints regarding the show to be put in writing to the Secretary.**
16. Any objection or protest must be handed into the Secretary's tent in writing within half an hour of the finish of the class, together with a deposit of £25, this will be forfeited if the objection is not sustained.
17. **All cups to be returned to Show office, Teme street Tenbury wells or Nick Champion, 16 Teme Street, Tenbury Wells, WR15 8BA on or before Friday 6th June 2026**
18. It is the Competitors responsibility to present themselves in the ring for judging on time.
19. **If classes clash due to entry numbers, competitors must decide which class to participate in and notify the stewards accordingly.**
20. All 1st and 2nd Prize Winners in the relevant classes to go forward to the Championship.
21. Riders must be of suitable height and weight for size of horse or pony being ridden.
